The dotted red lines on land of each section as are
 separated from the water by a public road, indicate
 that the land between the land and these dotted red lines
 forms a part of these sections.
 These red lines are marked at a parallel distance from
 the road of two chains, and a space not less than
 is reserved in the fullness between the water and the
 cut, at every interval of 10 chains water frontage, and
 a line runs down perpendicular to the waterway.
