Elevations in feet; Mean Sea Level, Port Adelaide.

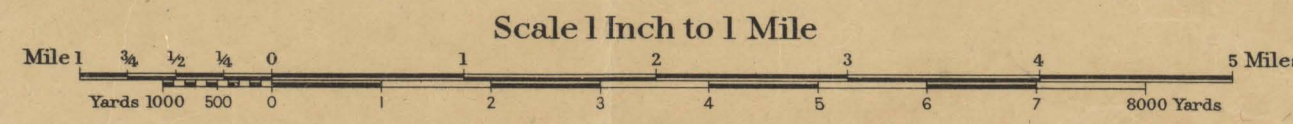

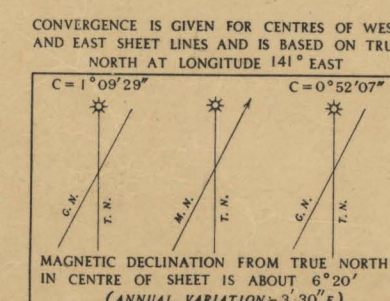
