Table with 2 columns: Road/Track Feature and Symbol. Includes symbols for various road types (concreted, metalled, earth), tracks, and railway lines.

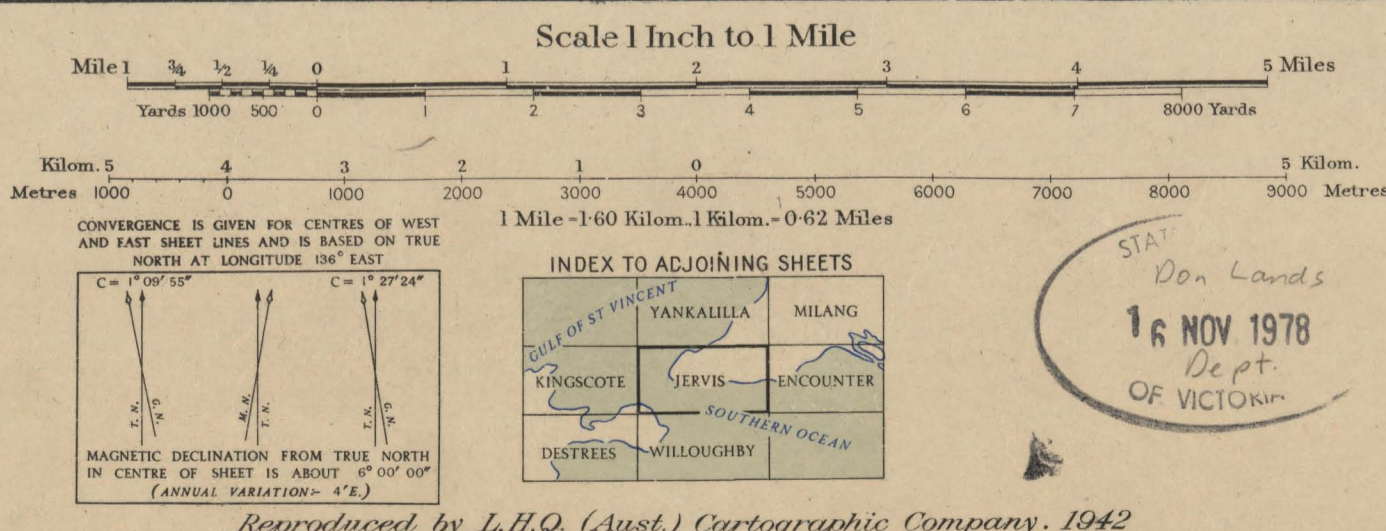
