

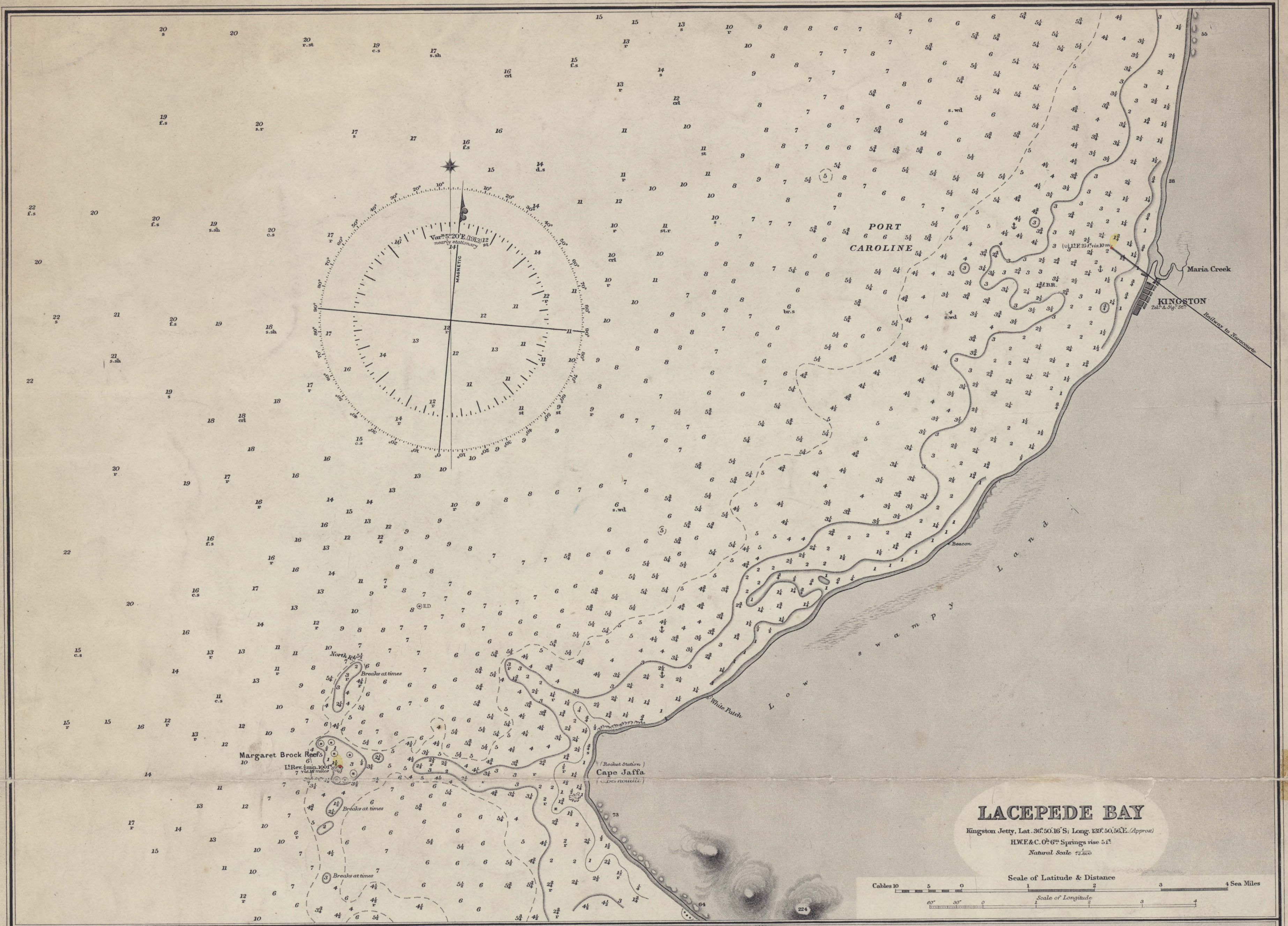

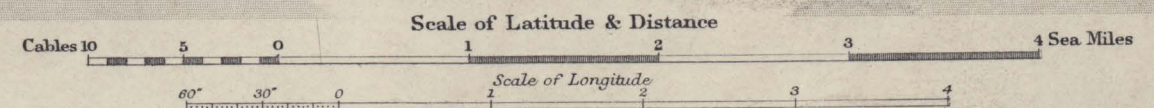
SOUNDINGS IN FATHOMS

The Long^s depend on Snapper Pt (Adelaide) being 136° 31' E.
Figures on the land express the heights in feet above high water.
Magnetic Variation in 1913, nearly stationary.
All bearings are magnetic.
